



## Senior Women's Amateur Championship | August 24-29, 2019 VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

There are many volunteer options during the 2019 USGA Senior Women's Amateur tournament. All volunteers are encouraged to register for 2-3 shifts. Each volunteer will receive a golf shirt, golf hat and meal voucher.

### **\*Walking Scorer**

Walking Scorers will enter hole-by-hole scores for all players in their assigned group into a hand-held scoring device provided by the USGA. The USGA will provide each walking scorer with training before the play begins. Must have the ability to walk 18 holes.

### **\*Real-Time Scoring**

Real-Time Scorers will assist with updating and maintaining all participant scores and will troubleshoot any issues with the handheld scoring devices. Volunteers should be comfortable with technology.

### **Scoreboard Assistant & Scorecard Runner**

Scoreboard Assistants will assist with reading scores, adding scores and hanging score sheets. Scorecard Runners will run the signed and attested score cards from the scoring tent to the scoreboard.

### **Marshals & Forecaddies**

Marshals will direct the flow of traffic around the course as-needed, enforce golf etiquette, and locate and protect errant golf balls on specified holes.

### **\*Practice Range Assistant**

Practice Range Assistants will help manage the operation of the driving range and practice green.

### **\*Standard Bearer**

Standard bearers will carry a scoring sign signifying the status of a designated match. Must have the ability to walk up to 18 holes. Standard Bearers are needed only on Wednesday, August 28 and Thursday, August 29.

### **Grounds**

Grounds volunteers will assist with roping, staking, traffic marshaling and replacing food and water for players on the course.

### **\*Caddies**

Caddies must have the ability to walk 18 holes with their player, which is assigned via a blind draw. Caddies must be available, at minimum, for 2 practice rounds and the 2 days of stroke play (August 22-25, 2019). Familiarity with the CRCC golf course is preferred.

### **Locker Room Assistant**

Locker Room Attendants will stay in the locker room and assist players with any of their needs.

*\* Volunteer assignments with an \* denote indicates that the volunteer must have the ability to walk the 18-hole course or remain on your feet, for up to four hours.*
